## INFORMATION ABOUT NEW MEMBERSHIPS IN 2011

Thank you for your interest in the Church Run pool. Enclosed with this information sheet is a **Membership Application** form. Please review this information closely before sending in your application and payment. New membership applicants should determine which type of membership is applicable and best suits their circumstances.

**MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION:** New memberships are available each year because some existing members from the prior year choose not to renew. In past years, the pool has reached its membership capacity prior to opening day. New memberships are available, subject to conditions listed below, on a first-come, first-serve basis, as determined by receipt of a properly completed membership application and payment. Applications received after the pool reaches the membership cap cannot be accepted, and the applicant's undeposited check will be returned.

The Church Run pool has two types of permanent memberships. Lot owners in Church Run and Windsor Place must join as Class A members and all other new applicants are Class B memberships. The total cost in 2011 for a new permanent membership is \$750 plus either a \$450 annual fee for a Class A membership or \$475 annual fee for a Class B membership. (*After March 31, 2011 fee is \$525 for a Class A membership and \$550 for a Class B membership*). Thereafter, permanent members who renew every year pay only the annual fee.

**Class B** memberships are permanent memberships for families who are not lot owners in Church Run or Windsor Place. This type of membership is not transferable.

**Class A** memberships are for lot owners in the communities of Church Run and Windsor Place only. This Class applies to new and renewal memberships. These memberships may be transferred by a lot owner, who is a member in good standing, to the purchaser of that member's home in Church Run or Windsor Place. Lot owners in Church Run and Windsor Place may also obtain tennis-only memberships, and should contact the membership committee for details. Lot owners in the communities of Church Run and Windsor Place are not eligible for Class B memberships.

There will be at least three home swim meets during the summer where the pool will be closed early. These dates will be posted in advance.

## **BABYSITTERS**

A. Members can purchase a child-care pass for their children for \$50 per sitter subject to restrictions listed below. Babysitter Passes are available for purchase at the front desk of the pool.

1. The fee for the pass cannot be pro-rated.
2. Each family membership must purchase a separate pass.
3. Family memberships cannot share a sitter on the same pass.
4. The pass is not transferable among sitters or family memberships.
5. The pass is valid only when the sitter is performing child care duties and accompanied by a Member.
6. Sitters may not bring non-members into the facility.
7. Sitters must be at least 16 years old.

## **GUESTS:**

- A. Fees: Daily guest fees are \$5.00 per person per day when purchased at the door. Members may pre-purchase nonrefundable daily guest passes in multiples of ten for \$25.00. Order forms for guest passes are available at the pool and members should allow two days notice to purchase.
- B. Members between the ages of ten, (or who have completed the fourth grade), and sixteen may bring only one guest at a time to the pool. Members who are nine or younger, or who have not completed the fourth grade must have an adult member present to bring a guest.
- C. A guest fee or pass is required of all non-members regardless of age who enter the pool area, even if they do not use the pool.
- D. Guests shall be accompanied at all times by a Member. The Member may not leave guests at the pool.
- E. The hosting Member must be at the pool when their guests arrive.
- F. The pool manager will deny admission to guests when the facility is at capacity.
- G. Residents of Church Run and Windsor Place who are not CRCR Members will not be admitted as guests, except for after hour events.

**SWIMMING LESSONS:** Instruction sessions for children may be offered beginning in mid-June if there is sufficient demand and qualified instructors are available. Instruction sessions are only for members in good standing and are not available to non-members. Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis. Registration will not be accepted at the time of the sessions. In order to adequately staff the sessions, it is important that children be enrolled as early as possible. Cancellation of a session could occur due to low enrollment. So, the success of these sessions can be assured by early enrollment. Refunds will not be given, except in the event of a canceled session. Swimming instructions may be taught only by persons who have been approved by CRCR or the pool's management company, except when parents or legal guardians are instructing their own children.

**SWIM & DIVE TEAM:** Church Run has excellent teams and competes in the Greater Richmond Aquatic League. Last year, there were over 220 team members! Registration is held in the first week of May and practice begins in mid-May. This is an excellent way for your child to get exercise in the summer and to make new friends.
